HISTORY OF PAN AFRICA CHILDREN ADVOCACY WATCH (PACAW) Inc. IN KORO-EKITI KWARA STATE, NIGERIA.

PACAW - The Pan Africa Children Advocacy Watch Inc., is a non-profit governmental organization with headquarters in United States of America.

The Founder and the President of the NGO is our son, Dr. S.A. Ayeni of Iloro's compound Koro, Ekiti LGA, Kwara State, Nigeria.

PACAW Inc. project program started in Koro in the year 2007. The president came home to visit his parent and he seized that opportunity to also visit the schools in the community.

The schools visited were confronted with numerous challenges ranging from inability to pay PTA teacher's salary to non-availability of very basic academic facilities. The missing facilities included chalk, furniture, and text books. All these aforementioned challenges were addressed accordingly, in consultation with the teaching staff. PACAW Inc. ACTIVITIES IN THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS UP TO DATE;:

• Two PTA teachers were absorbed with their salary package responsibility taken care of and substantially improved.

• Financial assistance was given to the Head Masters to run the schools while PACAW subsequently paid the the PTA levies for all the pupils in the school for a period covering 2007 and 2008

• Mathematics, Science and English language text books and stationaries were brought for the pupils in the school i.e. from primary 1 - 6.

Home Economics center was renovated by PACAW Inc. in memory of our Late Father, Pa. Titus Alabi Ayeni.

• The Home Economics center was also equipped with furniture and First Aid Box.

• Toilet facilities with water system were built for both male and female in the school.

• In January, 2014, PACAW Inc. employed 6 NCE teachers for the primary schools to make it 8 teachers on her pay roll at the primary school level.

PACAW Inc. ACTIVITIES IN THE SECONDARY SCHOOL LEVEL:

• At the Secondary School level, 3 teachers were employed in January/April 2014 i.e. 2 B.Sc. teachers and 1 NCE teacher making the total number of teachers in the service of PACAW Inc. eleven (11).

• In September, 2014, PACAW Inc. organized a five day Leadership Academy workshop for her employees, primary and secondary schools staff, Youth Corp Members (NYSC) and educated youth in Koro and her environs. Each day, about 24 to 35 attendants were registered and they were all entertained.

PACAW Inc. RECENT PROJECT ACTIVITIES

These are the projects up for dedication and commission on this fateful day. They are:

• Renovation of a building in primary school for computer and library units.

• 6 new sets of computer gadgets were supplied to the computer room.

• Purchase of a generator set for the computer center.

• Purchase of computer instruction books for primary 1 - 6.

• Furniture was also supplied to both the computer and library sections.

In the secondary school, the library building was renovated and was equipped with different text books, dictionaries, and reference books.
Reagents were also purchased for the secondary school science laboratory.

The mission of PACAW Inc. is to nurture and develop a new generation of vibrant leaders that will influence situations positively in Nigeria.

Parents/Guardian(s) are therefore advised/encouraged to release their children to access all these provided facilities.

On a lighter note a series of appreciations from schools, Koro Progressive Union (KPU) and Ekiti Local Governmental Education Authority Kwara State, Nigeria were also acknowledged.
